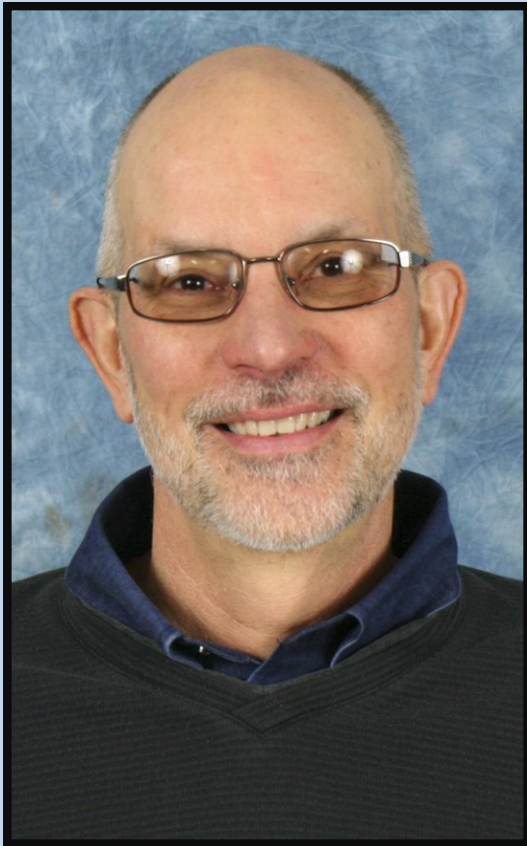


The Fourth Annual Servant Leadership Day
